



Shining a spotlight on our Trustees

Trustees are the ones who ensure that the charity is carrying out its purposes for the public benefit and is complying with its governing document. Trustees have overall legal responsibility. Trustees work collectively with the charity managers and take decisions at management meetings.

Russell Chamberlain, Chairman of Trustees Russell has a lot of experience working for the C of E as Priest in a number of locations including the South East, Okehampton and then Newton Abbot, along the way he has spent 13 years as a hospital Chaplain. Russell is an



experienced trustee having had this role with many charities over the years including Fostering & Adoption agencies, Homelessness and has served on many School Boards. Although he knew the area well Russell has only lived in Dawlish since 2020 and became a Trustee for AT when he finally retired because of his passion for and experience in the care sector. Russell has been a Trustee for Assist Teignbridge since 2021, having previously been a volunteer and has been Chairman for AT for the last 12 months.

Robin says "My hope for the future for Assist is that it can continue to build on its strengths and to serve and support the local community".


David, Trustee

What volunteer services do we offer?

Outreach Benefit Help for those of retirement age to claim Attendance Allowance, Pension Credit or carer's allowance.

Befriending Weekly visits or phone calls to those who are isolated.

Dog walking For those who are not able to walk their pets due to ill health or in covery.

Gardening basic gardening for those who are not able to look after their gardens through ill health.

Signposting to other services who may be able to help.

Brokerage to help other charities find volunteers.

Enabling Helping with difficult situations like shopping, food-bags or other further support.

Charged for services:

Assist Caring We offer a sitting service across Teignbridge to support carers to have a much-needed break. This can be during the day or overnight. We also provide practical help and personal care to individuals, helping them to live independently for longer.

Assist Home Help We support older people to remain living independently at home through the provision of domestic help. We can help with cleaning, vacuuming, dusting, mopping, laundry and shopping.

Assist Nail Trimming service We offer a home visit nail cutting service. This is to support older people and people who genuinely cannot manage their own foot care. However, we cannot treat people with diabetes.


